 A new version of the SsinHistory service will be deployed in order to use the new service of the Crossroads Bank for Social Security (BCSS).

This new version does not involve any interface changes and will be transparent for users.

3.3 Iris care Webservice Sync and Async MDA and Async facturation

• The member data service (= Member DAta = MDA) allows any institution or authorized care provider to consult the information (insurability and derived rights) of the care recipient necessary to carry out invoicing or to deliver services/products in a way correct. This synchronous service is a copy of the MyCareNet service for the new Brussels platform, IRISACARENET within the framework of regionalisation. This service will be under the responsibility of the CIB, which is the Collège Intermutualiste Bruxellois
