3.2 BelRAI Vlaanderen API

- a user-friendly BelRAI web application for individual care providers,

- a secure database for storing customer data and their assessments,
- a mobile application for use on smartphones
- the BelRAI web application in demo mode, to support training.

3.3 Consent

- addition of the physiotherapist target group
- Notification of change of status via ebox

3.4 eAgreement

- The "eAgreement" service will allow an authorized health care provider to send these requests for agreement electronically and also to consult them.
- Some physiotherapy treatments require a medical agreement in order to be able to claim reimbursement from insurance organizations.
- The eAgreement service will be opened to :
 - 1 Independent physiotherapists (regardless of the place of service: private practice, at home or in an institution);
 2. Doctors (Gp & Specialists)
 3. Groupings of GPs (both same place and different places)
 4. Medical houses;
 5. Nursing homes: MRS, MRPA, CSJ;
 6. Rehabilitation centers;
 7. Hospitals;
 8. Protected Housing Initiatives (IHP);
 9. psychiatric care homes (MSP);
